

Authorship declaration and confirmation

Please complete this form before requesting that a thesis be evaluated as a cumulative PhD dissertation **or as a non-cumulative PhD dissertation containing co-authored chapters** at the Department of Humanities, Social and Political Sciences at ETH Zürich.

This declaration details the candidate's individual research contribution for each paper/chapter constituting the thesis along the following two main dimensions:

- 1. Analytical input: substantial contributions to conception and design, or development and analysis of a theoretical model, or acquisition of data, or analysis and interpretation of data;**
- 2. Writing: drafting the article or revising it critically for important intellectual content.**

For each paper/chapter the declaration should be completed by the candidate and signed by the candidate and the co-author(s). Use additional form(s) if necessary. The last page should include all co-authors' signatures to ensure that the candidate and all co-authors have looked through the declaration and find the description in accordance with their personal view of the co-operation that has taken place.

The candidate is asked to indicate his or her contribution as a share of the overall effort of writing the article with respect to each of the two aforementioned criteria. This can be done with percentage shares (0-100%) or with qualitative terms, such as: "all", "most", "more than half", "half", "less than half", "some", "none", or alternatively "leading role", "major role", "minor role", "no role."

Optionally, this specification can be broken up into the subcategories listed under each of the two criteria, but a summary assessment for each criterion has to be given indicating the candidate's contribution as a share of the overall effort. Additional remarks can be added to further specify the candidate's effort and the division of labor among the authors.
